



Terms of Website Use

These terms and conditions form a legally binding agreement (the **Agreement**) between: CDA Eastland Trade Supplies Pty Ltd of 763 Hunter Street, Newcastle in the State of New South Wales (**CDAETS**, **we, us, our**) AND the person(s) or company visiting or patronising CDAETS's website: <u>www.cdaets.com.au</u>, (the User, you, your).

This Agreement will be deemed to be accepted by the User by visiting, viewing or using (including ordering from) the CDAETS website.

THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:

1. Intended Use
